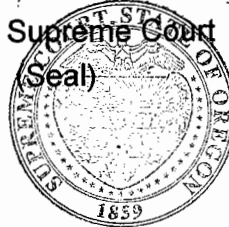

RESULT OF "YES" VOTE: "Yes" vote allows state/local cooperation and resources for immigration enforcement; requires certain documentation of citizenship for voter registration, "legal presence" for driver/identification documents.

RESULT OF "NO" VOTE: "No" vote retains current state/local limits on cooperation and resources to enforce immigration laws, current requirements for voter registration, grant of driver/identification documents.

SUMMARY: Current Oregon law: prohibits expenditure of state/local law enforcement resources solely to enforce federal immigration laws; allows only United States citizens to vote, and requires Oregon voter registrants to attest to, but not to document, voter qualifications; requires Oregon driver license, permit, identification card applicants to be Oregon residents or domiciliaries, provide social security number, proof of age, identity, residence.
